Paris has developed a first-rate infrastructure. Located at the very heart of Europe, it is completely accessible. In fact, all roads seem to lead to Paris: by air, with two international airports serving 324 destinations, or by rail, with 435 European connections daily by TGV.

After the visit of the palace, guests will walk in the gardens, to reach the restaurant La Petite Venise, where lunch will be served. These wonderful gardens were designed for the famous Sun King. Before returning to Paris, they will also visit the Queen's Hamlet. Marie-Antoinette, seeking to flee the Court of Versailles, ordered the construction of her hamlet in 1783. There, she regularly found the charms of country life, surrounded by her lady's companions.
